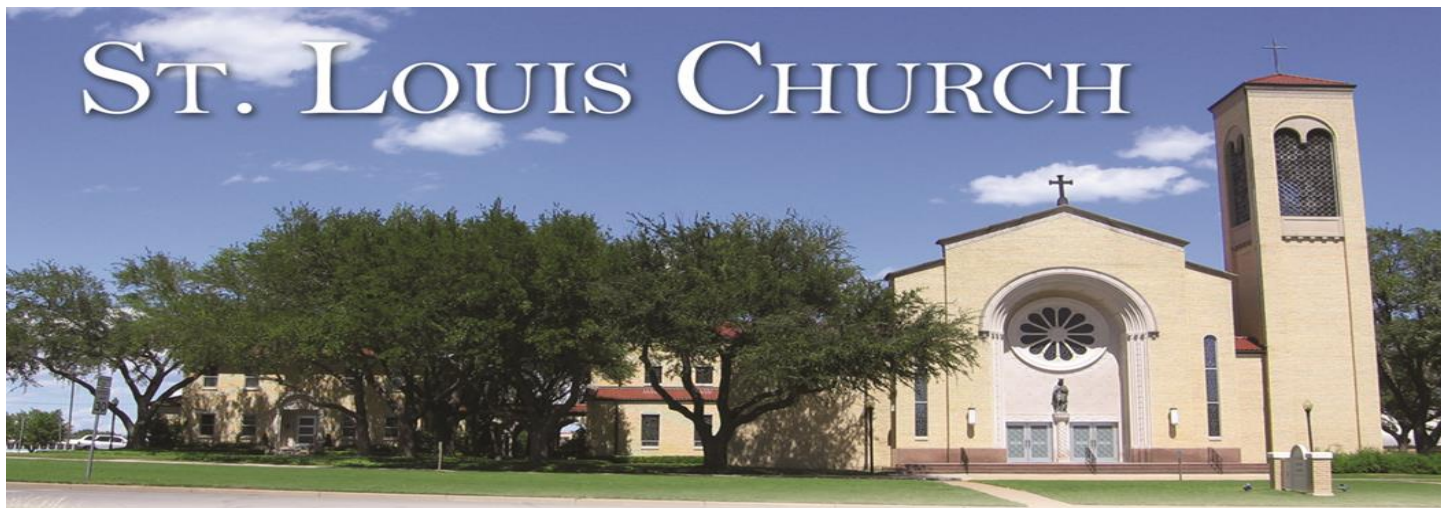

## Catholic Answers

How can we explain the Trinity to "Oneness" Pentecostals who says that Jesus is the only God and that the Father and the Holy Spirit are manifestations and not different persons of the Divinity? And how can we explain baptism in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost when they insist on Acts 2:38, repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus? Claiming the name of the three persons, or manifestations in their view, is Jesus.

### Answer

In Matthew 28:19 Jesus explicitly commands his apostles to baptize in the name of the Trinity. This is where the Church received the Trinitarian formula. It wasn’t some pope’s idea. In Acts 2:38 the author is not presenting a liturgical formula. He is concerned with distinguishing Christ’s baptism from John the Baptist’s. The practice of the early Church was thoroughly Trinitarian.
